¹**The program operating fee** is charged in lieu of tuition at OUS institutions. Students will receive credit from their home institution as though they paid regular tuition.

²**The program incidental fee and lodging** includes payments to the host university for orientation, language courses and administration. It also includes dormitory rent from April 1 to July 31, excursions and other program activities (including lodging and meals on excursions outside of Tübingen), textbooks and teaching materials.

³**The refundable dorm deposit** is required for student housing in Tübingen. You will receive a full refund after the end of the program provided you leave your room in the same condition in which you found it and do not owe any rent because you stayed beyond July 31.

⁴**Additional expenses** are estimates based on comments from past participants and information from the host institution. Students planning to do a lot of traveling while on the program may need to budget more.

** Individual OUS campuses will append a campus-based study abroad fee (approximately \$250-300 per term). This charge will be placed on your account at your home campus at the start of the term.

Every attempt will be made by the OUS International Programs Office to maintain costs at projected amounts.
